Transfer Guide

This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an **Associate in Arts** at Delta College who plan to transfer to complete a bachelor's degree in **History.** Students must earn a 'C' or better in each course and be admitted to the transfer institution and program.

Transfer Destinations:

Delta has transferable History courses that when combined with the Michigan Transfer Agreement, will transfer to many universities across the state into their bachelor's degree in History, including the following: Central Michigan University, Ferris State University, Saginaw Valley State University, University of Michigan-Flint and Wayne State University.

Savings:

Comparing tuition rates at many of the transfer destinations, students can save over \$20,000 on a bachelor's degree in **History** by completing their associate degree at Delta first, and then finishing their bachelor's degree requirements at the university. Delta's tuition is less than half what you would pay at a public university for the same quality education.
